

Food Service

The Board of Education directs School Nutrition Services to operate the National School Lunch and Breakfast Programs to ensure the free and reduced-price meal benefit is available to all students, who meet USDA eligibility requirements, each school day. In addition, the Board of Education directs that the following Federal regulations will be upheld:

- No student will be denied school breakfast or lunch as a disciplinary action.
- No student will be discriminated against because of his or her eligibility for free or reduced price meals.
- No student shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age or handicap, be excluded from participation in, be denied benefits of, or otherwise be subject to discrimination during any meal or function of School Nutrition Services.
- Confidentiality of information on the free or reduced-price meal application for each student will be strictly maintained per Federal requirements.

The sale of foods or beverages to students on the school premises other than through the school nutrition program is prohibited from 12:01 a.m. until the end of the last lunch period.
