Girls and Boys Soccer Schedule Fall 2009

2009 – 2010 School Year

- The home team is the team listed on the right side of the schedule.
- Unless otherwise indicated all contests will be played at the site-school of the home school.
- All admission prices will be \$5.00 per person (9th grade & up) and \$2.00 (K-8) for all regular season contests and jamborees unless otherwise indicated. Pre-school and under may enter contests at no charge.
- First matches during the regular season begin at 5:00 p.m.
- Each Jamboree will begin at 10:00 a.m.
- During the regular season, and rounds one and two of the playoffs, the girls will play in the first match unless the home team wishes to have the boys play first. It is the responsibility of the home school to inform all stakeholders of this change. The System-Wide Athletic Director must give approval for this change.
- The second match during the regular season, and if needed during rounds one and two of the playoffs, will start 15 minutes following the conclusion of the first match.
- St. Anne will play their home games at the Fort field. St. Anne will be responsible for paying officials, securing and paying for security, and securing and paying for stadium workers. St. Anne will set up their own concessions for their home games.
- Fort and St. Anne will not be able to utilize the concession building at the Fort complex.
- Angie Ramos will assign officials for all contests.
- The first official day of soccer practice will begin on August 17, 2009.
- Try-outs for soccer will be held on August 13 and 14, 2009.
- Middle School Physical Evaluations August 10 and 11, 2009 hosted by Rothschild
- The Kinnett Stadium scheduled events subject to change, if GHSA requires the use of Kinnett Stadium for any high school event.

IX. SOCCER CONTEST RULES AND PROCEDURES – NFHS, MCSD ATHLETIC HANDBOOK, AND GHSA

Section 1. A soccer match consists of two (2) thirty (30) minute halves and a ten (10) minute half time.

Section 2. Tie soccer matches (post-season) will be decided by penalty kicks. Tie soccer matches (regular season) will end at regulation time and team points awarded (See Section 4). This will eliminate the need to go to penalty kicks, which prolong the game, and with 2 games (boys and girls) scheduled at each site, penalty kick time could really add to game time. This method of settling tied matches should be included in the contract for soccer officials.

Section 3. A tournament composed of six (6) teams to determine the City Tournament Champion will follow the regular season schedule. Teams are seeded in the tournament according to their respective finish in regular season play. In the event of a tie, the teams with the least amount of goals against will advance, if the tie cannot be broken by the use of head-to-head competition contest results.

Section 4. 10-Point Standings Procedure

<u>Standing</u>	<u>Points Awarded</u>
Win	6
Tie	3
Goals Scored	1 per goal (Maximum 3 points)
Shut-Out	1

Example: If a team wins its game 3 to 0, they would pick up 10 points. If a team wins 1 to 0, they would only receive 8 points. Rarely are more than two teams tied with the same number of points at the end of a season. If two or three teams are tied, we follow the tiebreaker procedure outlined in Section 6.

Section 5. Points from the crossover games will not be reflected in a teams' cumulative points total. Therefore, crossover games will not figure into divisional standing.

Section 6. Playoffs/Tie-Breaker System for Playoff Berths

- a) Head to head
- b) Goals allowed
- c) If there is tie in goals allowed the next tie breaker would be penalty kicks at a neutral site.
